Lunch Program Update

We have had a successful start to the lunch program with lots of new volunteers (parents and grandparents!). Here are just a few notes to clear up any confusion:

1) **Please make sure the school has any info regarding allergies, intolerances or food restrictions for your child.** This information is then passed onto the kitchen. We do have several children with severe nut allergies therefore, No nuts or nut products are allowed at the school. As well, please review with your child the school's policy about not sharing food with other children.

2) Please review the menu with your child to ensure they understand their choices. For the first few months, it is a good idea to pop an extra snack in their bag in case they decide they don't like the lunch they ordered. **Milk is included with a paid lunch.** Milk can be ordered individually on any day. Just write a big M on that space.

4) **Juice requests-** If you mark the juice request box on the menu, the kitchen staff knows to allow juice if your child requests it.

Shepard's Pie (beef), Caesar salad (pork),pizza casserole (beef). We do offer certain menu choices meatless (i.e. lasagna)
