Report Card Pick-Up

On Thursday, June 18, one member from each of our Lakecrest families is invited to come to the school to collect each student's report card and any belongings that classroom teachers may have. In addition, the family member is asked to return any items that belong to Lakecrest (i.e. textbooks, novels, Library books, computers, etc.). Consumables, like workbooks and exercise books, are to remain home.

Keeping physical distancing practices in mind, we are going to stagger the arrival times of our families when they come to the school. We are asking all parents and/or students to maintain two arms' lengths between themselves and others when lining up to enter the school, and to avoid crowding at the entrance.

Keeping staff and student safety a priority, please follow the protocol as listed below:

- Please ensure that you adhere to the timeframes presented to keep things moving efficiently and safely and that you collect belongings and materials as promptly as possible and then exit the building**
- Please pay careful attention to posted signs and floor markings upon your arrival**
- Hand sanitizer will be available as you enter and exit the school**
- All drop-off and collection of items will occur in an organized fashion at the main entrance of the school**
- Ms. Gillingham and Ms. Parsons will be positioned behind tables, wearing masks and gloves to take the items you are returning, and will hand each person items that you need to take home.**
- Classroom visitation, at this time, is not permitted**

You may contact the office to make alternate arrangements if:

- You or someone in your household are feeling unwell or currently in self-isolation**
- Need to designate someone to pick up and drop off your child's belongings for you**

Families with last names beginning with A and B arrive between 9:00-9:30

Families with last names beginning with C through F arrive at 10:00-10:30

Families with last names beginning with G through K arrive at 11:00-11:30

Families with last names beginning with L through O arrive at 1:00-1:30

Families with last names beginning with P through S arrive at 2:00-2:30

Families with last names beginning with T through Y arrive at 3:00-3:30

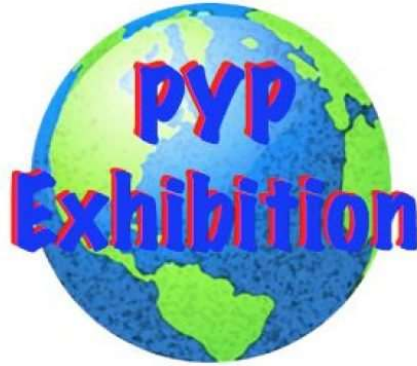
